Moving from Thanksgiving to Christmas, we delight to give gifts to one another, and our grateful thoughts turn toward the good gifts our Father has given us. We know that "every **good** gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change." (James 1:17) From the very beginning, he provided us all we need in His creation: "God saw everything that he had made, and behold, it was very **good**." (Genesis 1:31) Our hearts respond, "Oh give thanks to the Lord, for he is **good**; for his steadfast love endures forever!" (I Chronicles 16:34)

(Ephesians 2:10) This includes telling of his goodness and salvation to the very ends of the earth: "And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!" (Romans 10:15) Thanks to you for being part of these good works this year, participating with us in training missionary aviators to carry the gospel of salvation to the ends of the earth!
