The US Embassy in Port au Prince, Haiti, has scheduled our girls' visa final visa interview for this Thursday, September 6! If all goes well, the visas for travel to the US should be issued by early next week, and the Haitian government should issue travel authorizations to the girls the following week. Please pray with us that the visa interview would be successful, and that the resulting documents would be issued on schedule.
