We as Christians to help those struggling with life issues; to know who, how and when.

CEF missionaries in Washington state to have their own needs met, for peace, for zeal and help in their ministries. Please pray specifically for our family members, that all would believe in Jesus as Savior

and let Him be Lord of their lives.
