For a multi-relational, do-it-yourself kind of person this has been trying. I have had to miss significant ministry events. I have not been able to work on our new home on the other side of the mountain.

BUT, we have the BEST supporters ever! My son, AJ loaded up his three little boys in his car and drove from MN to WA to help us on our house for a week. My daughter, Kirsten and her husband and kids have come many weekends to help. My nephew, Jeremy has taken time out of his busy schedule to come and share his skills.
